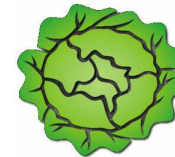


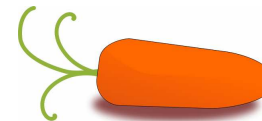


A new round of CSA is beginning, and we invite you to be a part of it.

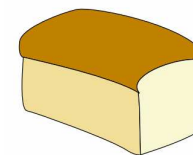
Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a way for farmers and customers in the community to share the risks and benefits of growing local sustainable food. The late summer CSA will be 6 weeks, beginning **August 7**. Membership are limited and must be paid in advance.



Joining CSA will provide you a fresh, authentically-grown bag of food once a week. Food can be picked up on Saturday mornings at the Portal farm stand or in Rodeo.



The baskets will include a variety of fresh produce, such as onions, garlic, chard, squash, basil, watermelon, and more. Eggs and fresh-baked bread will also be included.



We are also offering a **bakery only share** that includes a loaf of bread and one other item (such as scones, pizza dough, or granola) each week.
